- Womens Foursome First and second place prizes.
- Mixed Foursome Must be two women and two men.
   First and second place prizes.
- Senior Mixed Foursome Must be two women and two men. First and second place prizes.
- Senior Foursome First and second place prizes.
- Longest Drive Men and Women. First and second place prizes for Hole #7.
- Most Accurate Drive First and second place prizes for Holes #4 and #10.
- Closest to Pin Holes #3, #6 and #8 First and second place prizes (\$100 cash prize on hole #8).
- Christy's Challenge Hole #13 split the pot or win a sleeve of golf balls.

#### **Christy's Challenge Contest Rules**

Mulligans may not be used on this hole.

Give notification at the hole before hitting that you are a Super Ticket Holder or have purchased this ticket.

Men will play from white tees, seniors 68 years and over and women from red tees. If your tee shot ball lands on the green, you will receive a sleeve of balls.

Land inside the circle on the green and you will split 50% of the total cash contributed for the contest with any other golfer who did the same. The other 50% will go to Landis Adult Day Services.

# Putting Contest Sponsored by

#### **Tournament Rules**

- Men will play from white tees.
   Seniors 68 years and over and women from red tees.
- 2. All putts must be holed. No "gimmies."
- 3. Threesomes are required to take rotating shots. On Contest/Prize Holes, threesomes are eligible to win using first shot only.
- 4. Mulligans may be used on any shot except Closest to the Pin and Christy's Challenge.
- 5. Out of bounds (white stakes)—penalty—one stroke plus distance. Water hazard—penalty—one stroke.
- The Golf Tournament is a scramble. Therefore, just one official score card is needed per foursome. Turn in your score card to the desk in the Foxchase Club Golf Pro Shop immediately following the completion of 18 holes.
- 7. The tournament rules for the scramble.
  - A scramble means that all four team members tee off on each hole and then decide which tee shot they like the best and mark the spot with a tee or other marker.
  - b. The other team members pick up their balls and place them within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot. Each team member hits their next shot from the chosen spot of the prior shot.
  - This procedure is followed on every shot for the remainder of the hole, including putts.
  - d. Putts need to be placed within three inches of the marked spot (no closer to the hole). The first ball to go in the hole is counted for the team score.
  - e. If the ball you choose to play is in a hazard (sand, water, etc.), the rough, or out of bounds, you cannot drop the ball outside of the hazard or rough even if relief is within one club length away.
  - f. Each team must use at least one of each team member's tee shots on each nine (minimum two tee shots per player), except all-senior foursomes.
- 8. Speed of Play: Maximum strokes per hole—**double bogey**. "Be ready" golf etiquette.

If you need a rules interpretation, discuss within your designated foursome.
