Tournament Rules

- The Golf Tournament is a scramble. Therefore, just one official score card is needed per foursome. You can record your scoring in the app with your smart phone or turn in your paper score immediately, at the meal following completion of your round. See page 49 for scoring app links.
- 2. Men play from white tees. Seniors 68 years and older and women from red tees.
- 3. All putts must be holed. No "gimmies."
- 4. Threesomes are required to take rotating shots. On Contest/Prize Holes, threesomes are eligible to win using first shot only.
- 5. Mulligans may be used on any shot except Closest to the Pin and Christy's Challenge.
- 6. Out of bounds (white stakes) penalty one stroke plus distance. Water Hazard - penalty – one stroke.
- 7. The tournament rules for the scramble:
 - a. A scramble means that all four team members tee off on each hole and then decide which tee shot they like the best, and mark the spot with a tee or other marker.
 - b. The other team members pick up their balls and place them within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot. Each team member hits their next shot from the chosen spot of the prior shot.
 - c. This procedure is followed on every shot for the remainder of the hole, including putts.
 - d. Putts need to be placed within three inches of the marked spot (no closer to the hole). The first ball to go in the hole is counted for the team score.
 - e. If the ball you choose to play is in the hazard (sand, water, etc.), the rough, or out of bounds, you cannot drop the ball outside of the hazard or rough even if relief is within one club length away.
 - f. Each team must use at least one of each team member's tee shots on each nine (minimum two tee shots per player), except all-senior foursomes.
- 8. Speed of Play: maximum strokes per hole double bogey. "Be ready" golf etiquette.

Before hitting, give notification at the hole that you are a Super Ticket holder or have purchased this ticket.

Men play from white tees, seniors 68 years and over and women from red tees. If your tee shot ball lands on the green, you will receive a sleeve of balls.

Land inside the circle on the green and you will split 50% of the total cash contributed for the contest with any other golfer who did the same. The other 50% goes to Landis Adult Day Services.
